Contest Rules

1. Entries submitted must have been published during the 2007-2008 school year.
2. All articles and photographs must be mounted.
3. Page layouts do not have to be mounted, but an entry form must be included with the entry.
4. Web entries must include the URL (web address) and a hard copy.
5. Students may enter multiple categories in the newspaper, broadcast, yearbook, magazine and online divisions, but are limited to two entries per person, per category. If a student submits more than two entries in a category, all of the entries in that category will be disqualified.
6. If a yearbook, magazine or final edition of a newspaper has not yet been printed, proofs or hardcopies will be accepted with a note from the adviser certifying that the entry will be published.
7. There is a \$2 fee per entry. Make checks payable to: Maryland-DC Scholastic Press Association or MSPA.
8. **All entries must be attached to an original or photocopied entry form** and received by August 4, 2008 at the following address:
